

MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT

October 24, 1975

The President called at 2132 until 2135

The President said Henry Patee wanted to see me at 0930 in the morning. He said that Patee and the President wanted to play tennis with me at 2:00 p.m., between 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. I said fine. He said I should get the fourth. (Someone make sure that someone changes the plans that were arranged for tomorrow and just has one additional person come rather than two)

The President said he wanted to see Kissinger and me at 12:00 o'clock, between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m., together. He said he had told Henry the same thing he had told me earlier in the day and that Henry's reaction was identical to mine. I said that we should delay scheduling that until after Dick and I meet with him in the morning because he may want to change his mind.
