SUBJECT: Doctrine on Detainees (SF 991)

- **Answer.** Yes, the Joint Staff is incorporating detainee lessons learned into doctrine and training. (TAB)
- **Analysis.** The Joint Staff, working closely with the Army, recently updated Joint Publication 3-63 "Joint Doctrine for Detainee Operations" to reflect doctrinal lessons learned. It also updated associated tactics, techniques and procedures, documenting these revisions in "Joint Detainee Operations in the Global War on Terror." Finally, the Joint Staff is committed to departmental efforts like the Detainee Senior Leadership Oversight Council. Initiatives like this will ensure additional detainee lessons learned are quickly identified, and doctrine and training revised accordingly.
