SUBJECT: Meeting with Deputies on Detainees

Don,

I convened a meeting with the Deputy AG, DDCI and various others today to decide the disposition of the Danish detainee.

Given the various risks that need to be balanced, and the context of the UK releases, we agreed that it would be prudent to transfer the detainee to Denmark under the following conditions:

- a. The detainee agrees to:
 - i. Renounce armed Jihad
 - ii. No longer associate with terrorists
 - iii. To check in with Danish authorities on some frequent schedule
 - iv. Not leave the country
- b. The Govt. of Denmark will agree to:
 - i. Reaffirm with the detainee the conditions of the release, and to impress upon the Detainee that the Govt. of Denmark has agreed to the conditions with the US Govt.
 - ii. Be responsible to the US for the detainee and the detainee's activities

We also discussed some other detainee issues, in cluding the possible timetable for military commissions and the handling of the UK detainees (five to be transferred by the four most dangerous to be retained).
