SUBJECT: FY05 Foreign Military Financing (FMF) and International Military

Education and Training (IMET) Funding

• Congress completed work on the FY05 Foreign Operations bill on 20 Nov.

- IMET funded at \$88.56M (vice \$89.3M request).
- FMF funded at \$4.74B (vice \$4.96B request).
 - > Funds Pakistan at \$150M (vice \$300M request).
 - Option to transfer up to \$150M from prior year FMF and Economic Support Funds (ESF); however, these funds are likely not available.
 - State has advised DSCA they intend to address Pakistan shortfall through a supplemental.
 - ➤ Includes non-binding allocations for all FMF countries. Can be changed with Congressional notification.
