MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION
WITH FRANCOIS DE ROSE
At Lunch on Wednesday, August 1, 1973

- 1. The subject was Atlantic Relations. He wanted to know what the situation was in the United States. I told him there was no pressure for it at all, that it was something that the President cared about because it would provide a stable platform for the future for the partnership; but as far as public pressure, it didn't exist.
- 2. He told me that he had spent several days preparing some materials for his government and that he is pushing hard to get them to be responsive. He doesn't know what success he will have, but he feels he has a good case and that they are not unreceptive.
