MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: Visit of Deputy Supreme Allied Commander, Europe (DSACEUR) --

ACTION MEMORANDUM

General Sir Harry Tuzo (UK Army) is visiting national capitals making normal protocol calls customary for a newly incumbent Deputy SACEUR. He was appointed in March 1976 and this will be his first official visit to the United States. He plans to be in Washington only one day, the sixth of October, and will visit with the Chairman, JCS as well as Army and Air Force senior staff officers. General Brown will host a luncheon and Vice Admiral Hannifin (J-5) plans a reception in the evening.

I expect to talk with the General briefly in the afternoon of the sixth at 1615 hours. Since he has specifically requested a courtesy meeting with you, I recommend that fifteen minutes be blocked on your calendar beginning at 1630 hours.

Tuzo is a former commander of NORTHAG; it should be useful to get his views about his former command and the planned US brigade deployment. If you approve the call, I will accompany him to your office and provide appropriate background papers.
