MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: "Improving the Effectiveness of NATO's Theater Nuclear Forces"' - Status of Action in NATO -- INFORMATION MEMORANDUM

(C) Since the subject paper was introduced in NATO at the Hamburg NPG Ministerial, the following actions have taken place:

a. On 27 January 1976, <u>ADM Wienel, USREPMC, introduced the</u> _paper into the NATO Military <u>Committee</u> for assessment by NATO Military Author i ties (NMA).


b. <u>NATO Reqistry reproduced and distributed additional copies</u> for each NATO delegation eligible for participation in the NPG (less Greece) and those participating organizations that received the RD/FRD version of the paper.

c. <u>Sanitized versions of the paper were passed to both the French</u> and Greek delegations in early February.

d. SYG Luns has suaaested to the Chairman, NATO Military Commi ttee, that <u>preliminary military views should be made available to</u> <u>the NATO Permanent Representatives during April 1976</u> based on the assumption that the spring NPG Ministerial could take place during early June 1976.

e. The NATO Military Committee has tasked SACEUR and SACLANT to forward their first assessments of the paper by 5 April 1976. We understand that SACEUR plans to submit his definitive assessment by that date.

f. In response to a SHAPE request, a <u>J-5, OATSD/AE team is plan-</u> ning to visit SHAPE during the oerrod 1-5 March 1976. The team wi 11 provide assistance in the preparation of the SACEUR assessment of the



C) There have been no discussions related to the paper in the NATO NPG Staff Group, which could yet indicate the degree of acceptance or other reactions in NATO NPG countries. Some countries have said they will rely on the NATO Military Authorities' assessments. The Netherlands delegation has asked US Mission, NATO whether the Nike Hercules paragraph in the paper presages reductions in that system. The US NATO Defense Advisor has informed his Netherlands counterpart that the paper was provided to NATO as a vehicle to initiate frank discussion and that specific actions based on the paper are not appropriate at this time.
